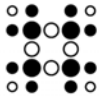

## Research, international collaboration, PhD-supervision

He has served as Principal Investigator of numerous externally funded research projects since the early 1990s. His research, initiated in the late 1980s (until late 1990s) dealt with management issues related to R&D management, env. management, technology development and implementation in large and complex high tech organizations. During the last decade focus has been on entrepreneurial high tech organizations, organizational development, interplay between human and technical systems, and decision making under increasing constraints. Supervised numerous doctoral students enrolled in Denmark and a few doctoral students enrolled at universities in Spain, Finland and China. His research has been funded by grants from The National Advanced Technology Foundation; The Danish Agency for Science, Technology and Innovation; The National Research Agency; The Danish Technical Research Council; The Danish Social Science Research Council; The Nordic Research Council and the European Commission.
